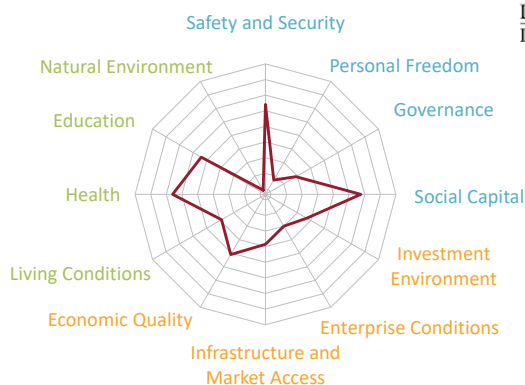
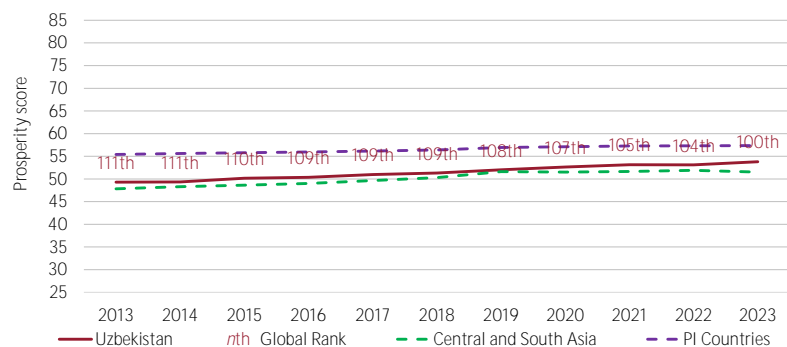


Uzbekistan: Prosperity score 53.8 (100th)
