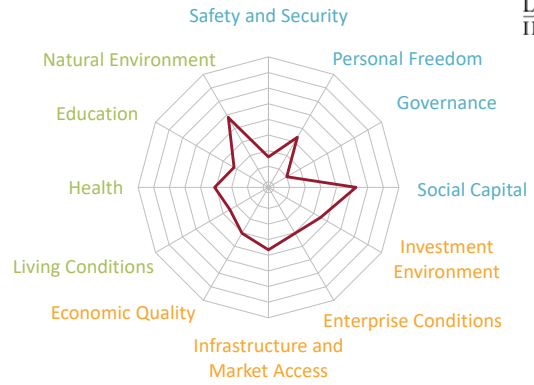
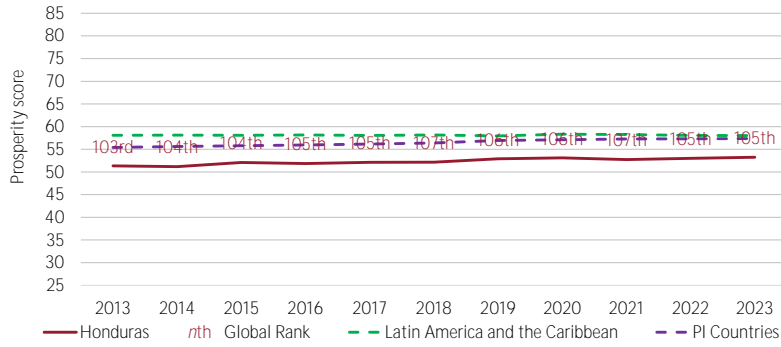


Honduras: Prosperity score 53.2 (105th)
